justice, nor any inappropriate circumstances which it believes would be curtailed by the

proposed rule.

However, if the Supreme Court decides to implement the proposed rule,

members of the conference have raised concerns that the rule needs to clearly define

"embellishments", since collars, lapel pins, jewelry, and other items occasionally worn

by judges with their robes could be considered embellishments.
